Applicants must have demonstrated on-going commitment to their community by performing unpaid volunteer services impacting hunger in the United States at least within the last 12 months. Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident. 12-07-2018 **The Comcast Leaders and Achievers® Scholarship Program** recognizes high school seniors for their community service, academic performance and leadership skills. We provide these scholarships to give young people the opportunity to continue their education to better compete in tomorrow's workplace.
