Deadline Scholarship Information

- 11-06-2017 **Allegra Ford Thomas Scholarship** is open to students with an identified specific learning disability, demonstrate financial need and a U.S. citizen. Applicant must be planning to attend a 2-year college or vocational/technical school. This is a national scholarship with one time award of \$2,500. - 11-06-2017: **Anne Ford Scholarship** is open to students with an identified specific learning disability, minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0; demonstrate financial need and a U.S. citizen. Applicant must be planning to attend a 4-year college/university. This is a national scholarship with one award of \$2,500 per year for 4 years. - 11-14-2017 **Jack Kent Cook College Scholarship Program** – Jack Kent Cooke Foundation College Scholarship Program is an undergraduate scholarship program available to high-achieving high school seniors with financial need who seek to attend and graduate from the nation's best four-year colleges and universities. Up to 40 students will become Jack Kent Cooke Scholars and have access to funding for up to four years for undergraduate studies. Scholarship amount is up to \$40,000. Eligibility reqs are minimum 3.50 unweighted GPA, SAT scores of math and critical reading of 1200 or a minimum Composite score of 26. Applicants must show demonstrated financial need. www.jkcf.org
- 11-15-2017: **Stokes Educational Scholarship Program** is sponsored by the National Security Agency, which protects the US government information systems. This scholarship program is open to students planning on majoring in computer science, computer/electrical engineering or math. Need to be a U.S. citizen, have a 3.0 GPA, 25 on ACT or a combined 1200 on SAT and demonstrated leadership ability. You must apply online at www.intelligencecareers.gov/nsa/nsastudents.html. Submit a resume online by clicking on "Student Programs" link in the left side menu bar and selecting "Stokes Educational Scholarship program". Follow directions as listed.
- 11-17-2017 **Modesto Peace/Life Center** is holding an essay contest. This contest is open to grades 9 through 12. The 11th and 12th grades are in Division I of the contest and 9th and 10th grades are in Division II. Awards will be given to applicants in each division. By talking with others and researching, gain an understanding of both the common reasons why people become homeless and solutions which have been tried. Write a 500-1000 word essay. Scholarships are valid for 2-year or 4-year colleges/universities. - 12-11-2017: **California Association of Education Office Professionals** – The CAEOP Student Scholarship (\$1,000) is provided to assist business education students who wish to continue higher education and pursue a career in business administration or education.
