- 11-15-2018 **The Sullivan Leadership Award** is a 4-year scholarship that covers tuition, room and meals at Seattle University. Successful applicant must have a rigorous college preparatory coursework and academic achievement, participate and demonstrate leadership, committed to justice and good of others through service and effective communication skills. Applicants must apply to Seattle University for Early Action admissions and complete the Sullivan Leadership Award application by Nov. 15th. **Applications are online at www.seattleu.edu/sullivan/.**
- 11-15-2018 **Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarships** range from \$1,000 per year to \$12,500 per year, Most Valuable Student scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree, on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), in a U.S. college or university. Applicant must demonstrate leadership, academic achievement and financial need. **Application is available online at www.elks.org/ENF/scholars/mvs.cfm.**

Up to 40 students will become Jack Kent Cooke Scholars and have access to funding for up to four years for undergraduate studies. Scholarship amount is up to \$40,000. Eligibility requirements are a minimum 3.50 unweighted GPA, SAT scores of math and critical reading of 1200 or a minimum Composite score of 26. - 11-30-2018 **Sixt Scholars** offers 5 scholarships in the Sixt Scholars program. Each scholarship is valued at \$5,000. Applicants must have an unweighted GPA of 3.7 or higher. Scholarships are valid for 2-year or 4-year colleges/universities. Sixt will consider the first 500 valid scholarship applications they receive, so do not wait to long to fill out the scholarship application at **<https://www.sixt.com/sixt-scholars/>**.

11-30-2018 **Dr. Juan Andrade Jr. Scholarship for Young Hispanic Leaders** is open to students attending or accepted to two-year or four-year institutions that demonstrate a need for financial support.
